LAR Large Animal Rescue Training Held

It was another beautiful day at the Grand Adventures Ranch in Sonoita Az., when 2 trainers and 14 students came to a very valuable training. Deb and John Fox from Felton Ca., own and operate The Large Animal Rescue Training. With a wealth of knowledge, they train owners, first responders, stable owners or just an animal lover, the techniques needed to extricate animals in emergency situations. Students are taught to analyze a situation and to use the proper equipment as not to further the animals injuries. They even have a 2 horse trailer that is laid on it's side so students can become familiar with the procedure to extricate a horse in case of a rollover. Students learn the proper equipment, knots and team work to make the rescue successful.

The first day was classroom work and the second day was hands on. The group was broken up into 2 teams with one trainer and a helper to assist. Deb and John are excellent trainers and have the safety of the animal in mind. They have an excellent web site at largeanimalrescuetraining.com.

Care For The Horses will be conducting fundraisers through the year so that funds will be available to purchase the equipment needed. All the training in world won't do us any good if we don't have the equipment to do so. We will also be hosting another training in the latter part of 2009.
